

LessLoss Power Distributor connection suggestions

Our best suggestion is to start with outlet #1. There, connect the first device in your audio chain (the first powered device that creates or sees the signal). Then, follow the audio chain down your system, such that the last item according to the listed outlets would be your power amp(s).

As for the Live/Neutral configuration, you will see that LessLoss power cords have a red marking on one of the legs of the Schuko wall plug. That indicates where the Live line must enter the LessLoss power cable. Now, when you connect such a cable correctly from your wall outlet, the distributor will have the correct Live/Neutral lines going through it and into the correct Live/Neutral contacts on each of the 6 outlets.

The outlets each have markings on the nylon mouldings. These are “Line” (which stands for Live) and “Neutral”. Please note that on one row of three outlets the “Line” marking is on one side, and on the other row the “Line” marking is on the other side.

Make sure to adhere to this for all power cables. Only this way will the true results follow.



The USA/Japan version follows the same connection scheme, only here, because of how duplex outlets are wired in pairs of two, #1 below consists of two individual outlets. #2 and #3 likewise.
